Mark Del Monte, JD, CEO/Executive Vice President (Interim) of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Prior to this role, Mark served as the AAP's Chief Deputy and Senior Vice President for Advocacy and External Affairs where he directed the organization's communications, public relations and advocacy activities.

Jen Thomas, MD, MPH, is a breastfeeding medicine specialist at Aurora Healthcare in Franklin, Wisconsin and is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Community and Family Medicine and Pediatrics at the Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW). She has been an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLC) since 2003. She is now serving on the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Section on Breastfeeding Executive Board after spending several years as the Chief of the Chapter Breastfeeding Coordinators.

Kelly Schmidt, MD, is a Pediatric Neurological Surgeon practicing at the Neuroscience & Spine Institute. Dr. Schmidt earned her medical degree at the George Washington University School of Medicine in Washington, D.C., and subsequently completed her neurological surgery residency and pediatric neurological surgery fellowship trainings at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas.

Colleen Wood, MD, is a board certified pediatric endocrinologist practicing in the Billings Clinic Pediatric Subspecialty department in Billings, Montana. She trained in pediatrics in Denver, Colorado at Children's Hospital Colorado from 2005-2008, and completed a Chief Residency year from 2008-2009 at the same institution. She spent a three year fellowship in diabetes and endocrinology at the Barbara Davis Center for Childhood Diabetes in Denver. She has been practicing in Montana in the capacity of pediatric endocrinologist since 2015

Melisha Hanna, MD, is Director of Dialysis, Clinic Medical Director, and Director of Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy, Pediatric Nephrology/The Kidney Center at Children's Hospital Colorado, she focuses her practice on children with proteinuria, polycystic kidney disease, nephrotic syndrome, kidney stones and kidney failure.

Subspecialist Panel: This workshop aims to provide PCPs with a high-yield review of common pediatric subspecialty topics, covering the fields of cardiology, pulmonology, gastroenterology, urology, neurosurgery, critical care, medically complex care, surgery, and neonatology. Speakers form a panel of local subspecialists, each of whom will review a common presenting complaint in their subspecialty field. Each subspecialist's topic will cover epidemiology, presentation, criteria for referral to subspecialty care, and strategies for management. Topics will incorporate illustrative, de-identified cases from Montana as appropriate. Objectives will be to: (1) Recognize the presentation of important subspecialty conditions, (2) Name red flags for referral to subspecialty or higher level care, (3) Develop strategies for long-term management or co-management
