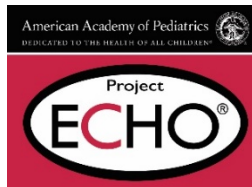

The Montana Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics is recruiting primary care practices and public health clinics to join a 4-month learning collaborative aimed to educate and support primary care providers on adolescent vaccination workflow, best practices in overcoming vaccination hesitancy, and increasing adolescent vaccination rates in your community.

Practices will engage in the ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) model™, a telementoring platform that leverages video conference technology to connect subject matter experts with primary care teams in local communities, fostering an “all teach, all learn” approach.

Benefits of participating:

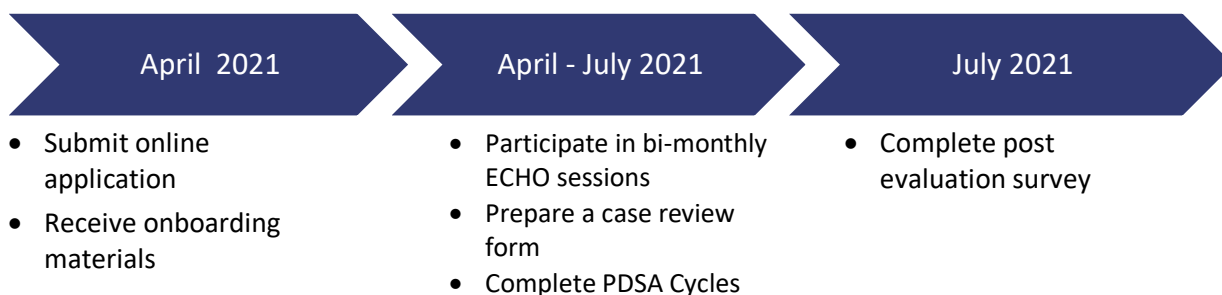
- ✓ Improve workflow and gain an understanding of best practices for adolescent vaccinations
